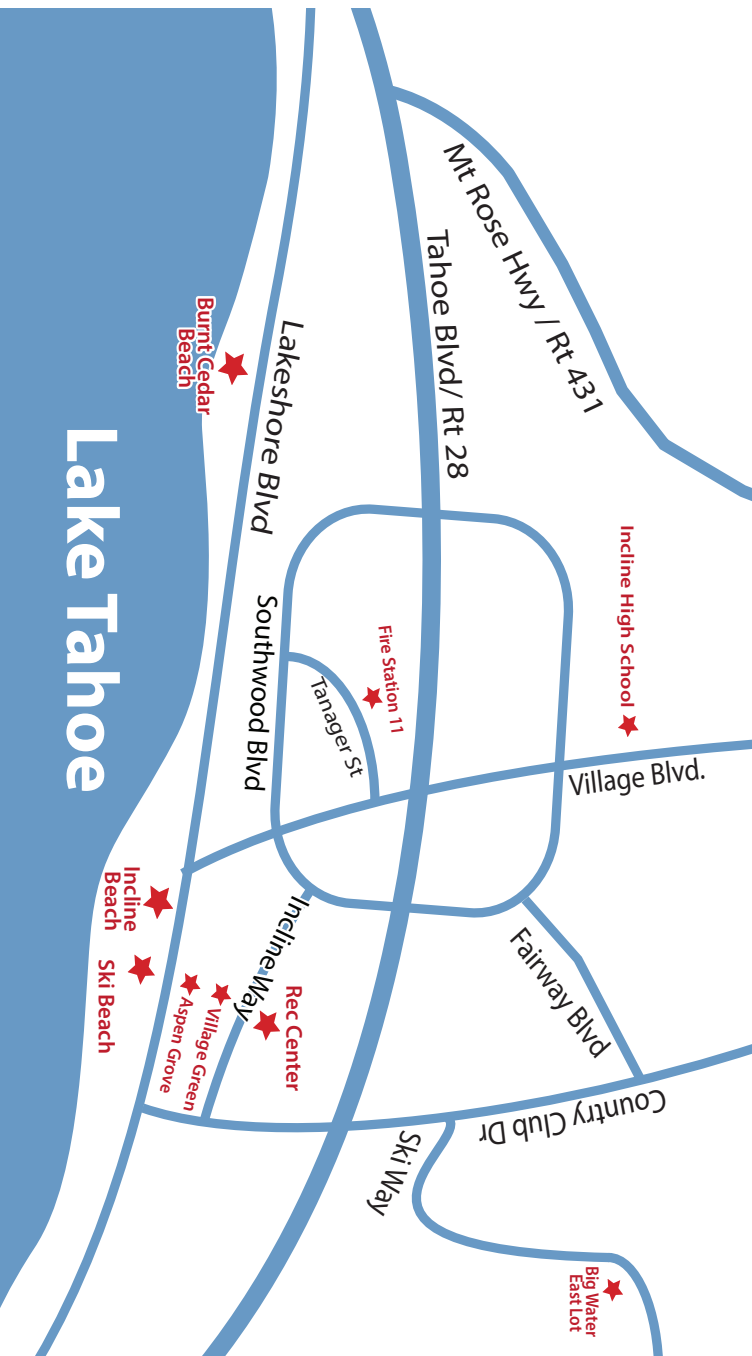


Venue & Shuttle Map

- ★ **Incline High School:** 10:40am - 9:20pm
- ★ **Burnt Cedar Beach*:** 10:50am - 11:30pm
- ★ **Incline Beach*:** 11:00am - 11:30pm

Times are approximate. Expect delays due to traffic. Shuttle does not run 4:50-5:50pm. Extended pick-ups at the beaches with drop-offs to all stops after the fireworks. See map on reverse.
